

Advisory Board recommends projects in Graz, Lackenbach, Kobersdorf and Ybbs/Göttsbach

The Advisory Board unanimously resolves to recommend the Board of Trustees that in future applicants must submit applications that comply with the Guidelines and have been checked and approved by a civil engineer.

The Advisory Board agrees to recommend the applications submitted by the Jewish Community Vienna for the cemeteries Graz, Lackenbach and Kobersdorf on the condition that costs for measures that were planned but not implemented be removed from the applications. This was also to apply to all future applications.

Moreover, the Advisory Board of the Fund unanimously recommends the Board of Trustees to approve the application of the Jewish Community Vienna for the cemetery Ybbs/Göttsbach (subject to conditions).

The Advisory Board of the Fund unanimously resolves to postpone the application of the Jewish Community Vienna for the expansion of the burial site database.

The Advisory Board of the Fund unanimously resolves to recommend the Board of Trustees to establish an additional permanent deadline for applications, 1 September.
