



Jewish Cemetery Salzburg

Description

The cemetery in the district of Aigen was founded in 1893. During the Nazi era, a number of gravestones went missing. After World War II, the burial site was returned to the Jewish Community Salzburg. The cemetery contains around 450 graves and a memorial remembering the desecration of the cemetery by the Nazis. The cemetery is kept locked. Information on guided tours and accessibility can be obtained from the Jewish Community Salzburg.
