## Jewish Cemetery Bad Aussee

### Description

The small cemetery forms part of the cemetery of the Parish of Bad Aussee situated on Grundlseer Straße. Bad Aussee was a popular summer resort and was often visited by Jews before World War II. In the event of death, burials were carried out locally; this is how this cemetery, which was not connected to a Jewish community, came into being. There are about a dozen gravestones in the cemetery; it is unlocked and open to the public.
