

## Jewish Cemetery Klagenfurt

### Description

The ca. 900 m<sup>2</sup> cemetery, which was established in the Klagenfurt suburb of St. Ruprecht in 1895, and was attached to the local cemetery, served as a burial site for the small Jewish Community of Klagenfurt. In total there are 97 headstones and four memorial plaques. In 2012 the perimeter wall, the green spaces, the gate and the remembrance plaques were renovated or renewed.
